All volumes are “quarter bound” with leather spines unless marked differently (two volumes).

All are Maroon leather, with Red/Maroon cloth on face of volumes.

All original bindings were carried out by “Duncan’s” bookbinders in Liverpool, who were the official bookbinders for MM.

All “gold” blocking on spines is reasonably matched, but bindings were carried out at different times. Most spines on volumes are faded and at different levels.

Tears at top of spine are due to mishandling when removing off shelf. (By previous owner!).
